## Hello from **CRASH** student ministries!

I believe as you are reading this month's newsletter, I am in Branson with 17 students on our first long distance retreat Disciple Now weekend. I have named this retreat **"The Great Escape"** because we see many times in the Bible where Jesus would "escape" to the wilderness, mountains, lakes, gardens, etc. just to get away for prayer to the Father or to have little "retreats" with the disciples. I believe it is good to be like Jesus and to escape the craziness of the world around us. We will be hiking with the students into some mountain areas and even an old abandoned town. As we hike these trails, I plan to stop and use these moments to teach the students about Jesus, the Hebrew children, and even about sinners like ourselves in the Bible. Please be in prayer for us as we travel and study.

I would like to thank each and every one of you that have been donating to our youth through our **"Show the Youth Some Love"** envelope campaign. We are still short of our goal but I believe that God will provide for these students. Our goal this year is to take at least 30 students to summer camp and to see their lives changed for the Kingdom of Heaven.

We have a couple of events planned for April already. **APRIL 1ST** we are going to Monroe to the **\*\*Escape Poom\*\*** and to eat out somewhere over there. This is a way to celebrate our own Brad Kimbell turning into the old man of 40!! and to have fellowship with our students. More details to come.

On **APRIL 28-29** we will be doing a **"30 HOUR FAMINE"** weekend. Our students will be participating in a juice fast for 30 hours. They are only allowed to drink one glass of juice each hour for all 30 hours plus as much water as they like. We will allow them to chew bubble gum as this is a very serious time of fasting and prayer. Most students can barely fast between breakfast and lunch (myself included!). I've done several of these over the years to raise awareness and donations for world wide hunger. We ask that you prayerfully consider donating to the hungry around the world. 100% of all money collected goes straight to the starving world wide. Our students will be given donation info packets the first Sunday in April. We ask that you would consider donating \$30 or more because most people around the world survive on \$30 per month. That is less than a dollar a day. I truly believe in this cause. I will also need chaperones for this event (at least 4), plus help cooking a very nice meal for the night of the 29th as we break our fast.
